## A day of fun and fellowship

Dear Christ Church,

I'm excited to tell you about "Christ Church Away Day" on Saturday 3rd October. This is a day for the whole church family to come together at Otford Manor - the home of the Oak Hall Christian Team.

Otford Manor is a lovely location, just far away enough to feel like an outing, but not so far as to hinder people attending.

The day will begin at 9.30am (for 10am) and will provide an opportunity for the church family to socialise and spend time together! There are lots of different activities to do - indoors and out - which include table tennis, pool table, exercise equipment, tennis court, badminton court, croquet lawn, volleyball court or simply walks in the countryside or sitting in the grounds - the open-air swimming pool will probably be closed.

*There will be no separate arrangements made for children and young people. We would encourage families to liaise with one another so that their children's friendship groups can be together and thus share the supervision between themselves.*

At 12 noon, after a morning of leisure time, we will gather to think about the vision for the church over the next few years. (The Leadership Team and others have been thinking into this subject over the last months). It will be a great opportunity to share with this the adults in the congregation. While this is going on, Jo Gavin and Andrena Palmer have promised to organised activities for the children and young people. There will be times of worship and prayer, as well as a time to ask questions about the vision and direction of the church. Most of all, however, we hope to strengthen our bonds of commitment to one another throughout the day.

There will be a lunch break in the Dining Hall (a lovely old Tudor Barn full of character with ancient oak beams that provides the very best of traditional English meals and culinary delights with a wide range of flavours and recipes from around the world).

After lunch there will be a chance to enjoy any facilities you were unable to partake in during the morning.

There will also be plenty of time to visit the Manor Bookshop which is well stocked with a wide range of Christian books, commentaries and Bible study aids.



The day will finish with tea and biscuits at 4.00pm so that people can depart by 4.30pm.

At certain times of the day, people from the prayer team will be available to pray with you in the Prayer Room.

Oak Hall is easy to reach by road - just 15 minutes from Junction 5 of the M25. For those of you without a car, lifts can be arranged by the church office.

Instructions on how to get there will be given in September 2015.
