#### **Dear Christ Church,**

Last week Sharon shared about the **Go Deeper** evening series. Alternating with that is the **Reflect** evening series which I lead. I'm so grateful to Anne Pini for singing at these services and to Andi for his invaluable tech support. These services are designed to give us time and space to encounter God away from the noise and stress that often characterises 21st-century life. That doesn't mean that we ignore the challenges and difficulties we face, but we can view them from a different perspective in a thoughtful and meditative way. Everyone is welcome to join us.

Our current series is called New Beginnings and focuses on the aspects of our lives that are 'new' in Christ: a new self, a new covenant, a new command, a new creation, a new spirit and a new name. God is doing a 'new thing' among us but sometimes we don't see it or are looking in the wrong place. Perhaps we don't think He can use us or we're not prepared for the disruption something new may bring.



I well remember the early days of having a baby in the house – the baby who is now 6'-5" and is at university. We had to buy new furniture, decorate a bedroom and check for sharp edges around the house, not to mention dealing with nappies, new smells and a lack of sleep! Or maybe you've just moved house and understand only too well the chaos that ensues. And yet the new baby is a thing of wonder, a delight, a miracle; and the new house will be far more suited to your needs once the boxes have been emptied.

These new things that God is doing are things that only He can bring about. When we become a Christian, a lot of things change. We have been redeemed from the kingdom of darkness to the kingdom of light. The good news is that the Holy Spirit changes us from the inside out. As we grow and develop our faith, we find ourselves wanting to serve God wholeheartedly. This doesn't mean we all have to start training to become a vicar (although that is one possibility)! God has given us our family, our friends, our workplaces and our activities as well as our church; He asks us to serve Him wherever we are.

In January 2014 something new began – Veganuary! I don't know if you've tried to do this, but my son Tristan is only eating vegan food for the whole month. It's quite a challenge, especially as he doesn't like vegetables! It takes quite a lot of discipline, but it's also introduced him to many new flavours, foods and recipes.

In the coming weeks, are you willing to try something new? It may be a new kind of diet (weight-loss groups traditionally do well this month), a new activity or a different way of thinking. Are we also willing to let God do something new in us? Yes, it will mean change, but we will be astonished at the result.
