SUNDAY 27TH FEBRUARY AT 10.30AM

Just one week to go until renowned international evangelist J.John comes to speak at Christ Church! What a huge blessing this is for us, and I am so looking forward to it, he is such fun!

I first heard J.John speak in the 1990's when he was giving a course called "Just 10". It was a ten-week course on the Ten Commandments, going through exactly what each commandment meant, and then inviting people who wanted to respond to what he had said to the front for prayer. Towards the end, there was the opportunity to surrender things that were part of people's sinful lives – to put them anonymously into dustbins - as a sign that they wanted to turn their back on that sin for good. If I remember correctly, J.John gave us a week's notice that this would be happening, and it was extremely powerful to make that symbolic and very real act.

That course was one of the milestones of my Christian Walk, and after the "Thou shalt not steal" week, I found myself at home wrapping up three books I had kept from the school library when I left, and posting them back to the school with a sorry note. I hadn't realised it weighed so spiritually heavy on my conscience until the Lord reminded me of it. After all, I had reasoned, I was the only one who ever borrowed them, and they were signed out to my name, so the school could have asked me for them if they wanted them back! Oh dear... Thank the Lord for His mercy and forgiveness. And now it is our chance to host this anointed teacher of God's word, and hear him explain what it means to be a Christian to us; and give us the opportunity to invite all our friends and neighbours who might not be so sure; and have the joy of seeing them touched by the Holy Spirit and seeds of Life being sown. All we have to do is invite them, and help them get here!

However many people you have invited, I'd like to invite you to spread your net wider and invite some more. I can almost promise you it will be worth it. The worst thing will be to hear this anointed man speak, see lives changed, and sit there thinking "I wish so-and-so had been here! I wish I'd had the courage to invite them!"

God honours sacrifice for His Name. Let me encourage you to step out into the sacrifice of suffering possible embarrassment or rejection for His Name. In the light of eternity, you will never regret it. You might even see a miracle.
