

Dear all, greetings from LBC

We wanted to update you on the situation regarding the purchase of the new minibus for LBC. As I wrote previously, we had to sell our old minibus and it went to serve further in Ukraine. So far, we managed to raise around 17,000 Euros and we are short of our target by 8,000 Euros. The plan is to purchase a second-hand (3-4 years old) minibus either in Germany or Sweden in November. The minibus is very much needed for the needs of LBC ministry. Please join us in prayerful consideration regarding this need. Thank you.
