

True and False:

What is truth, where can we find it and how can we be certain it is actually TRUTH.?

We all encounter this searching question many times in our lives and a range of spheres with varying consequences. I would suggest that it's even more frequent than we care to imagine:

- on the sports field; is that in or out, a try or no-try? And even after serious slow motion video analysis there is often still too much doubt to know either way.
- when I am asked to do something and I do it wrong; could it be that I heard wrong, understood wrong or could the instruction have been a little bit unclear? Sometimes it depends on your vantage point and with what baggage I enter a conversation to what I understand was actually communicated.

I have heard a brilliant quote that says: "The biggest problem with communication is believing that it has actually happened", now let's ponder that for a second.

I was having this conversation about truth with one of my dearest friends this week. I love him and respect him and to be able to wrestle with topics like these in a safe environment is such a privilege.

As we pray together and search together, may I encourage you to read the account of Jesus' trial before Pilate in John 18:28-40. Pilate is in a position of immense power. When he makes a decision, that decision becomes the law. He has the ability to set Jesus free and what he decides will be deemed final. Pilate interviews Jesus to try and get to the truth, and Jesus (like only Jesus can) tells this man, who has Jesus' life in his hands, the truth!

"Pilate said, "So you are a king?" Jesus responded, "*You say I am a king. Actually, I was born and came into the world to testify to the truth. All who love the truth recognise that what I say is true.*" "What is truth?" Pilate asked. Then he went out again to the people and told them, "*He is not guilty of any crime.*"
John 18:37-38 NLT

"I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one can come to the Father except through me." John 14:6


