As each one of us walk our path on this earth it is so incredibly reassuring to know that God is with us. He is inside of us as the Holy Spirit and guides us during the intimate time we spend with him and through his Word. For many of us the journey is often not straightforward and the 'satnav' doesn't always alert us to what may be ahead. In fact, a journey that does not come with obstacles and one that does not require frequent readjustments are infrequently part of our personal stories.

So, as we pray together, I would like us to spend some time focusing on how we deal with curveballs en route;

- Unexpected things that will come across our path, can easily unsettle us. Sometimes they are from the Devil but other times they are merely 'obstacles' for us to traverse. Whatever and for whatever reason they are there, our response needs to be prayer. Prayer should not be a last resort or an emergency escape hatch, but our very first port of call. God is ready to listen and to guide us no matter how insignificant or insurmountable the matter ahead of us appears.
  - "Don't worry about anything; instead, pray about everything. Tell God what you need, and thank him for all he has done." Philippians 4:6 NLT
- Along our journey we have a zillion choices to make, every day, constantly. Some choices are rather immaterial (what shall I wear); others much more life impacting (what job shall I do); other life altering (who shall I marry) and finally life-saving (what do I believe).

Furthermore, the inability to make a decision can also be such a debilitating thing that to grow and progress we HAVE to make decisions, big and small. Fortunately, yet again, we have the miracle of prayer; a direct line, that never has poor reception, and is always available on speed dial! All we need to do is 'be' with God and he is ready to listen and guide - Amen!

So, as we pray together, may we pray wild and reckless prayers, not looking at our own satnav, but listening to God, like a rally driver listens to their co-driver, never in doubt! Amen
