I have been pondering the concept of hope. We have been praying together for some time now and I am certain that there have been times when we all question if God is actually listening to our prayers. I want to take this opportunity to encourage you (and encourage myself) to keep praying!

Do you remember that feeling when you first came before God with a specific request; a dream, a release, a healing or something else; the excitement and enthusiasm you felt because you realised you are speaking to the creator of the universe, your Abba Father, who hears you and wants to give you what you ask for? But now, so much time has passed and still your prayer remains unanswered...

But I want to ask you to please continue to pray, because God is listening. Use this time to lean deeper into His loving arms, because you will smile with joy again:

"You know what I am going to say even before I say it, Lord. You go before me and follow me. You place your hand of blessing on my head. Such knowledge is too wonderful for me, too great for me to understand!" Psalms 139:4-6 NLT
