## Reflection

### Resurrection Life

Last week we celebrated Jesus's resurrection. It was a privilege to be at such a joy-filled service, and I hope, like me, you felt built up in your faith. Thank you to all those involved. I'd like to say a special thank you to the Easter Choir and the Gospel Choir. There was a real sense of us celebrating together.

During the week we also said goodbye to Don Bisset, a faithful member of our church family over many years. During his thanksgiving service, we heard the reading from John 14:1-6 with its comforting words about Jesus going ahead to prepare a place for us. That passage ends with this claim from Jesus:

*'I am the way and the truth and the life.  
No one comes to the Father except through me.'*

The comforting words at the start of the chapter give way to this challenge. Why do I call it a challenge? It's a challenge to the concept today that everyone can have their own truth and do life their own way. Christianity is the only religion which says God came to earth, lived as one of us, died for us and was resurrected for us. How amazing! More than that, Jesus himself is unique. He said and did things that no-one else ever has. He lived a perfect life, conquered death and proved it by being raised to life. No wonder we can celebrate.

And so we live in the light of the resurrection:



- We have **freedom** – freedom from sin, freedom from shame, freedom from our past
- We have **comfort** – death is not the end; if Jesus was raised then we will be raised
- We have **hope** - hope for an abundant, meaningful life now, and a sure and certain hope for our eternal future

Let's never become so familiar with the fact that Jesus was raised from the dead that we forget how momentous it was. The resurrection changes everything. Let's live in the comfort, hope and freedom that Jesus won for us.


## THE INSANITY OF GOD
